

tion, based on the principles of the sovereign equality of all peace-loving states, and open to membership by all such states, large and small, for the maintenance of international peace and security.

5. That for the purpose of maintaining international peace and security pending the reestablishment of law and order and the inauguration of a system of general security, they will consult with one another and as occasion requires with other members of the United Nations with a view to joint action on behalf of the community of nations.
6. That after the termination of hostilities they will not employ their military forces within the territories of other states except for the purposes envisaged in this declaration and after joint consultation.
7. That they will confer and coöperate with one another and with other members of the United Nations to bring about a practicable general agreement with respect to the regulation of armaments in the post-war period.

Organisation, hvilende paa Grundsætningen om alle fredselskende Staters suveræne Ligeberettigelse, og aaben for Medlemsskab for alle saadanne store og smaa Stater.

5. At de vil raadføre sig med hverandre og, naar Omstændighederne kræver det, med andre Medlemmer af de Forenede Nationer med Henblik paa fælles Oprætningen paa Nationernes Samfunds Vegne med det Formaal at opretholde mellem-folkelig Fred og Sikkerhed indtil Genoprettelsen af Lov og Orden og Indførelsen af et System for almindelig Sikkerhed.
6. At de efter Fjendtlighedernes Afslutning ikke vil anvende deres militære Styrker paa andre Staters Territorier, undtagen til de Formaal, der er omhandlet i denne Erklæring, og efter fælles Raadslagning.
7. At de vil raadføre sig og samarbejde med hverandre og med andre Medlemmer af de Forenede Nationer for at tilvejebringe en anvendelig almindelig Overenskomst med Hensyn til Regulering af Rustninger i Efterkrigstiden.
