

to be associated with it when the efficient discharge of the Committee's responsibilities requires that such a State should participate in its work. Questions of command of forces should be worked out subsequently.

(10) The members of the Organisation should join in affording mutual assistance in carrying out the measures decided upon by the Security Council.

(11) Any State, whether a member of the Organisation or not, which finds itself confronted with special economic problems arising from the carrying out of measures which have been decided upon by the Security Council should have the right to consult the Security Council in regard to a solution of those problems.

*(C) Regional Arrangements.*

(1) Nothing in the Charter should preclude the existence of regional arrangements or agencies for dealing with such matters relating to the maintenance of international peace and security as are appropriate for regional action, provided such arrangements or agencies and their activities are consistent with the purposes and principles of the Organisation. The Security Council should encourage settlement of local disputes through such regional arrangements or by such regional agencies either on the initiative of the States concerned or by reference from the Security Council.

(2) The Security Council should, where appropriate, utilise such arrangements or agencies for enforcement action under its authority but no enforcement action should be taken under regional arrangements or by regional agencies without the authorisation of the Security Council.

(3) The Security Council should at all times be kept fully informed of activities undertaken or in contemplation under regional arrangements or by regional agencies for the maintenance of international peace and security.

10) Medlemmerne af Organisationen bør i Fællesskab yde hverandre Bistand ved Udførelsen af de Forholdsregler, hvormod Sikkerhedsraadet har truffet Beslutning.

11) Enhver Stat, hvad enten den er Medlem af Organisationen eller ej, som kommer til at staa overfor særlige økonomiske Vanskeligheder, der opstaar som Følge af Gennemførelsen af de af Sikkerhedsraadet besluttede Forholdsregler, skal have Ret til at raadspørge Sikkerhedsraadet med Hensyn til en Løsning af disse Vanskeligheder.

*(C) Regionale Aftaler.*

1) Intet i Pagten skal udelukke regionale Aftaler eller Institutioner, der skal behandle saadanne Sager vedrørende Opretholdelse af mellemfolkelig Fred og Sikkerhed, som egner sig til Foretagelse af regionale Skridt, forudsat at saadanne Aftaler eller Institutioner og deres Virksomhed er i Overensstemmelse med Organisationens Formaal og Grundsætninger. Sikkerhedsraadet skal fremme Bilæggelse af lokale Twistigheder gennem saadanne regionale Aftaler eller saadanne regionale Institutioner, enten paa Initiativ af de paagældende Stater eller efter Henvisning fra Sikkerhedsraadet.

2) Sikkerhedsraadet skal, hvor det er hensigtsmæssigt, benytte saadanne Aftaler eller Institutioner til Tvangsforanstaltninger under dets Myndighed, men ingen Tvangsforanstaltung maa iværksættes i Medfør af regionale Aftaler eller af regionale Institutioner uden Sikkerhedsraadets Bemyndigelse.

3) Sikkerhedsraadet skal til enhver Tid holdes fuldt underrettet om Foranstaltninger til Opretholdelse af mellemfolkelig Fred og Sikkerhed, der er truffet, eller som paatænkes i Henhold til regionale Aftaler eller af regionale Institutioner.
