Dear Mr. Broadley,

According to instructions received by cable yesterday I hereby beg to advise you that my Government have now accepted the London proposal of August 1945, according to which the enclosed prices should be paid for the exports of butter and bacon from Denmark to the United Kingdom. The prices cover the period from May 1945 to the 31st December 1946 incl.

At the same time I beg to confirm the agreement reached during the negotiations in Copenhagen at the end of August 1945, to the effect that the price of eggs exported from Denmark to the United Kingdom should be as follows:
