Thank you for your letter of the 4th October conveying the agreement of your Government to the prices to be paid for butter, eggs and bacon to be supplied from Denmark to the United Kingdom from May 1945 to the 31st December, 1946, inclusive.

I am repeating on the enclosure to this letter the prices agreed to. We accept your letter and this acknowledgment as a binding arrangement on both sides.
