**TO THE AGREEMENT ON NORTH
ATLANTIC OCEAN WEATHERS
STATIONS**

Services to be performed by ocean station vessels.

A - Meteorological Services.

1. Meteorological observations shall be made on all ocean station vessels in accordance with the following programme:
 - (a) surface observations, eight times daily, the observations to include all elements prescribed by the International Meteorological Organisation for ships' observations;
 - (b) special observations of meteorological phenomena and of important changes, which may occur between the regular observations;
 - (c) upper wind observations not less than four times daily, such observations to be made normally by radar methods. In the event of failure of the radar equipment, however, the observations shall be made by visual methods;
 - (d) upper air pressure, temperature and humidity observations four times daily, whenever practicable, and, in any case, not less than twice daily.
2. Reports of the observations referred to in paragraph 1 above shall be transmitted to the appropriate shore stations in the prescribed International Codes.
3. Reports of observations from other ocean station vessels may be received and retransmitted in accordance with national or bilateral arrangements.
4. Reports of observations from an ocean station vessel shall be transmitted to aircraft, on request, in plain language,

**TIL OVERENSKOMST VEDRØRENDE
SKIBSSTATIONER I NORDATLANTEN**

Tjenester der vil være at udføre af stationsskibene.

A - Meteorologiske tjenester.

1. Der skal på alle stationsskibe foretages meteorologiske observationer i overensstemmelse med følgende program:
 - (a) Overfladeobservationer 8 gange daglig, hvori medtages alle de af den Internationale Meteorologiske Organisation for skibsobservationer foreskrevne elementer.
 - (b) Særlige observationer af meteorologiske fænomener og betydningsfulde ændringer, som måtte forekomme mellem de faste observationstider.
 - (c) Højdevindsobservationer mindst 4 gange daglig, der normalt vil være at foretage ved hjælp af radar. Såfremt radarudstyret måtte svigte, skal observationerne dog foretages ved hjælp af theodolit.
 - (d) Observationer af tryk, temperatur og fugtighed i de højere luftlag, såfremt muligt, 4 gange daglig og i hvert fald mindst 2 gange daglig.
2. Meldinger vedrørende de i stykke 1 ovenfor omhandlede observationer skal sendes til de behørigke kyststationer i de foreskrevne internationale koder.
3. Meldinger vedrørende observationer foretaget fra andre stationsskibe kan modtages og videresendes i overensstemmelse med nationale eller tosidede aftaler.
4. Meldinger vedrørende observationer foretaget fra et stationsskib skal efter anmodning sendes til luftfartøjer i
