

(4) The information services shall be available to Governments of Contracting States and their nationals and residents. The Assembly may decide to make these services available also to others.

(5) (a) Any service to Governments of Contracting States shall be furnished at cost, provided that, when the Government is that of a Contracting State which is a developing country, the service shall be furnished below cost if the difference can be covered from profit made on services furnished to others than Governments of Contracting States or from the sources referred to in Article 51(4).

(b) The cost referred to in subparagraph (a) is to be understood as cost over and above costs normally incident to the performance of the services of a national Office or the obligations of an International Searching Authority.

(6) The details concerning the implementation of the provisions of this Article shall be governed by decisions of the Assembly and, within the limits to be fixed by the Assembly, such working groups as the Assembly may set up for that purpose.

(7) The Assembly shall, when it considers it necessary, recommend methods of providing financing supplementary to those referred to in paragraph (5).

Article 51

Technical Assistance

(1) The Assembly shall establish a Committee for Technical Assistance (referred to in this Article as "the Committee").

(2) (a) The members of the Committee shall be elected among the Contracting States, with due regard to the representation of developing countries.

(b) The Director General shall, on his own initiative or at the request of the Committee, invite representatives of intergovernmental organizations concerned with technical assistance to developing countries to participate in the work of the Committee.

(3) (a) The task of the Committee shall be to organize and supervise technical assi-

4) Oplysningsstjenesten står til rådighed for de kontraherende staters regeringer og for statsborgere og bosatte i disse stater. Forsamlingen kan beslutte at stille oplysningsstjenesten til rådighed også for andre.

5) a) Alle tjenester ydet de kontraherende staters regeringer ydes til kostpris, dog således, at tjenester ydet regeringen i en kontraherende stat, der er et udviklingsland, ydes til lavere pris under forudsætning af, at forskellen kan dækkes af provenuet af tjenerster ydet andre end de kontraherende staters regeringer eller af midler fra de i artikel 51, stk. 4, nævnte organisationer eller institutioner.

b) Ved „kostpris“ som nævnt under a) forstås en pris, svarende til omkostninger ud over dem, der normalt er forbundet med en national myndigheds ydelse af tjenester eller med opfyldelsen af en international nyhedsundersøgende myndigheds forpligtelser.

6) Enkelthederne i forbindelse med gen nemførelsen af bestemmelserne i denne artikel fastlægges ved beslutninger truffet af Forsamlingen og — inden for de af denne fastsatte grænser — af sådanne arbejdsgrupper, som Forsamlingen måtte nedsætte med dette formål.

7) Når forsamlingen anser det for nødvendigt, anbefaler den andre veje til finansiering ud over de i stk. 5 anførte.

Artikel 51

Teknisk bistand

1) Forsamlingen nedsetter en komité for teknisk bistand (i denne artikel benævnt „komiteen“).

2) a) Komiteens medlemmer vælges blandt de kontraherende stater med behørig hensyntagen til udviklingslandenes repræsentation.

b) Generaldirektøren opfordrer på egen foranledning eller efter anmodning fra komiteen repræsentanter for mellemstatslige organisationer, der har til opgave at yde teknisk bistand til udviklingslande, til at deltage i komiteens arbejde.

3) a) Det er komiteens opgave at organisere og overvåge den tekniske bistand til
