

10. Each State Party, during transportation, sampling, storage and destruction of chemical weapons, shall assign the highest priority to ensuring the safety of people and to protecting the environment. Each State Party shall transport, sample, store and destroy chemical weapons in accordance with its national standards for safety and emissions.
11. Any State Party which has on its territory chemical weapons that are owned or possessed by another State, or that are located in any place under the jurisdiction or control of another State, shall make the fullest efforts to ensure that these chemical weapons are removed from its territory not later than one year after this Convention enters into force for it. If they are not removed within one year, the State Party may request the Organization and other States Parties to provide assistance in the destruction of these chemical weapons.
12. Each State Party undertakes to cooperate with other States Parties that request information or assistance on a bilateral basis or through the Technical Secretariat regarding methods and technologies for the safe and efficient destruction of chemical weapons.
13. In carrying out verification activities pursuant to this Article and Part IV (A) of the Verification Annex, the Organization shall consider measures to avoid unnecessary duplication of bilateral or multilateral agreements on verification of chemical weapons storage and their destruction among States Parties.
- To this end, the Executive Council shall decide to limit verification to measures complementary to those undertaken pursuant to such a bilateral or multilateral agreement, if it considers that:
- Verification provisions of such an agreement are consistent with the verification provisions of this Article and Part IV (A) of the Verification Annex;
  - Implementation of such an agreement provides for sufficient assurance of compliance with the relevant provisions of this Convention; and
  - Parties to the bilateral or multilateral agreement keep the Organization fully informed about their verification activities.
10. Enhver deltagende stat skal under transport, prøvetagning, lagring og tilintetgørelse af kemiske våben give sikkerheden for mennesker og beskyttelse af miljøet den højeste prioritet. Enhver deltagende stat skal transportere, udtage prøver, lagre og tilintetgøre kemiske våben i overensstemmelse med sine nationale normer for sikkerhed og udslip.
11. Enhver deltagende stat, som på sit territorium har kemiske våben, der ejes eller besiddes af en anden stat, eller som befinder sig nogetsteds under en anden stats jurisdiktion eller kontrol, skal gøre sit yderste for at sikre, at disse kemiske våben fjernes fra dens territorium senest et år efter denne konventions ikrafttræden for dens vedkommende. Hvis de ikke er fjernet inden et år, kan den deltagende stat anmode Organisationen og andre deltagende stater om at yde bistand til tilintetgørelsen af disse kemiske våben.
12. Enhver deltagende stat påtager sig at samarbejde med andre deltagende stater, som anmoder om oplysninger eller bistand på bilateral basis eller gennem Det Tekniske Sekretariat vedrørende metoder og teknologier til sikker og effektiv tilintetgørelse af kemiske våben.
13. I forbindelse med Organisationens gennemførelse af verifikationsvirksomhed i henhold til denne artikel og til del IV (A) i Verifikationsbilaget skal den søge at undgå unødigt overlappning af bi- eller multilaterale aftaler indgået mellem deltagende stater om verifikation af beholdninger af kemiske våben og disses tilintetgørelse.
- Med henblik herpå skal Eksekutivrådet beslutte at begrænse verifikationen til foranstaltninger, som supplerer de i henhold til en sådan bi- eller multilateral aftale foretagne, såfremt det finder, at:
- verifikationsbestemmelserne i en sådan aftale er i overensstemmelse med verifikationsbestemmelserne i denne artikel og i del IV (A) i Verifikationsbilaget;
  - gennemførelsen af en sådan aftale giver tilstrækkelig sikkerhed for, at de relevante bestemmelser i denne konvention overholdes; og at
  - de i den bi- eller multilaterale aftale deltagende stater holder Organisationen fuldt ud informeret om deres verifikationsvirksomhed.
